To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Rigdon Ervin of Monroe County Mississippi*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Columbus* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Rigdon Ervin*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section thirty, in Township thirteen South, of Range sixteen West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Columbus, Mississippi, containing thirty nine acres and ninety seven hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Rigdon Ervin*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Rigdon Ervin*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Rigdon Ervin*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
